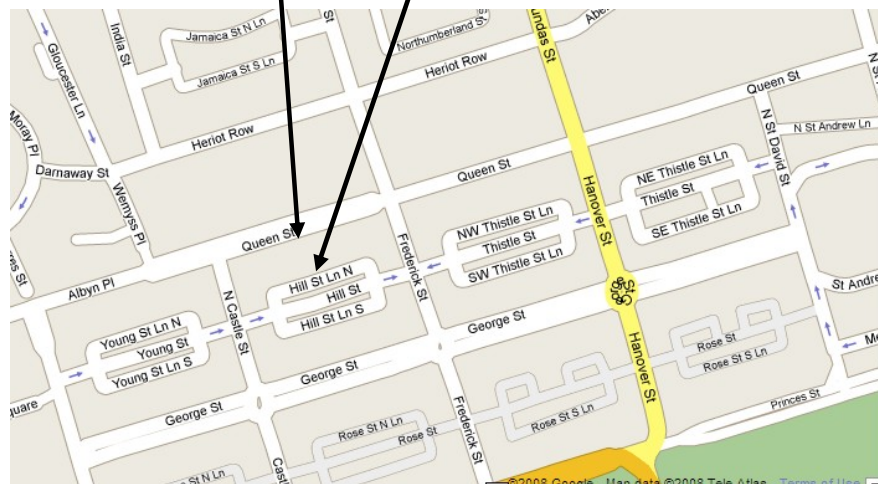

Traveling to our Edinburgh Office

Please see below directions to our office by air, by car, and by rail.

In all cases, please arrive at our front door on Queen Street so that reception can welcome you into the building.

When you arrive at the office, use the top button to call reception. If there is no answer, please use the alternative bells.

Traveling by Rail

Edinburgh's main railway station (Waverley) is in the city center, at the East-end of Princes Street. To reach the DEM Solutions office, come out of the stations onto Princes Street and turn left. Walk past the Scott Monument and cross the road at the National Gallery complex. Turn right on Frederick Street and follow the road up to the roundabout. Cross directly over George Street and continue on Frederick Street to the other side. When you reach Queen Street, turn left: DEM Solutions is located at no 49. The walk should take you about 10-15 minutes.

Traveling by Air (then on to city centre)

Edinburgh Airport is eight miles (12km) from Edinburgh city center. Airlink buses into the city depart from outside the terminal entrance and operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week, with a journey time of 25 minutes. The bus goes to Waverley Station (please see directions above).

The taxi rank at Edinburgh Airport is also outside the UK and Ireland arrivals hall. The average fare to the city centre is £16, and most of the taxis are wheelchair accessible. For further information on the Edinburgh Airport taxi service call Executive Onward Travel on +44 (0)131 333 2255.

Edinburgh Shuttle provides a fleet of seven-seater executive mini-buses and runs every 15-30 minutes between the airport and city. The shuttle picks up and drops off anywhere within the Edinburgh City Center zone. This can be from any address - home, hotel, business or conference venue.

Traveling by Car

Because Edinburgh is located at the heart of the Scottish motorway network, it can be surprisingly quick and easy to get here by car. If you're traveling from the north of Scotland for example, Edinburgh is only 3 hours from Inverness and just over 2 hours from Aberdeen. Journey times from England are just as good; you can get here from Birmingham in about 5.5 hours, from Manchester and York in about 4 hours, and the city is just 2.5 hours from Newcastle.

- The drive from the airport is approx 6 miles and will take around 20 minutes.
- Turn right onto the A902.
- At Maybury Junction turn left onto the A8 (signposted City Centre)
- At Drumbrae Roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the A8 (signposted City Centre, Murrayfield, Haymarket)
- Turn left onto South Charlotte Street
- Continue forward onto Charlotte Square and onto North Charlotte Street
- Turn right onto Young Street
- Continue forward onto Hill Street and turn off on Hill Street Lane North and DEM Solutions Car Park.
- Arrive at EH2 3NH, Edinburgh

To park in our car park, please call or email reception (reception@dem-solutions.com) to make arrangements for your visit. There is also metered pay-and-display street parking at the front of the building.
